Easter Eggstravaganza!

Materials:

- ☐ Flour (1 cup)
- ☐ Salt (½ cup)
- Water (½ cup)
- ☐ Mixing Bowl
- ☐ Rolling Pin
- □ Baking Sheet
- ☐ Egg Shaped Cookie Cutter
- ☐ Parchment Paper/Wax Paper
- □ Straw
- ☐ String/Twine
- □ Paint
- ☐ Paint Brushes



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Activity:

- 1. Mix flour, salt, and water into a mixing bowl.
- 2. Knead dough for approximately 10 minutes.
- 3. Roll out dough (approximately ¼ inch) on parchment paper to prevent dough from sticking.
- 4. Using a cookie cutter, cut out the easter egg shape and place on a baking sheet.
- 5. Using a straw, punch a hole at the top of the egg.
- 6. Set aside to dry. For a quicker dry, bake in an oven at 300 degrees for about an hour.
- 7. Get creative! Decorate eggs using paint, glitter, etc.
- 8. Let eggs dry.
- 9. Loop string/twine through the hole on the egg, tie the ends of the string/twine together.
- 10. Hang up the eggs!
